INSTRUCTOR Roy Hoxea, D.D.S. began his orthodontic training in 1985 under the direction of the late Dr. Charles Yates. He began using the Differential Straight-Arch® Technique when it was introduced in 1987. Dr. Hoxea is a member of the American Orthodontic Society and past president of the Academy of Gp Orthodontics. He has actively served on the Academy's Board of Directors and is currently serving on the Advisory Board. In September 1994 Dr. Hoxea was acknowledged for his outstanding achievements as clinician and was the first recipient of the Academy's Charles D. Yates Distinguished Service Award.

Dr. Hoxea graduated from Loyola University School of Dentistry in 1976, where he was a member of the teaching faculty. He also served as a clinical supervising dentist at Harper College dental programs in Palatine, Illinois and was instructor for Head and Neck Anatomy in the dental hygiene program. Dr. Hoxea resides in Fountain Hills, Arizona where he is currently a Comprehensive Care Unit Clinical Director at the Arizona School of Dentistry and Oral Health in Mesa. He is an alumnus of the L.D. Pankey Institute for Advanced Dental Education, a member of the American Dental Association and component dental societies.



CO-INSTRUCTOR/HOST Fred Der, D.D.S. graduated from University of Western Ontario in 1980, and is currently in private practice in Keswick, Ontario. Dr. Der completed the Academy of Gp Orthodontics training program in 2000. He has been mentored by Dr. Roy Hoxea, Dr. Ron Austin, and Dr. Sylvan Morein. Dr. Der has been a host dentist and clinical instructor since 2002, in the AGpO's Canadian program. First ever outside of the United States.

Currently, he is the president elect of the AGpO and will co teach the upcoming program in combination with Dr. Hoxea in Canada. He received his fellowship in Orthodontics from AGpO and IAO in 2008, and his FAGD, and MAGD in 2005. He is currently a member of the Canadian Dental Association.
